## HN6000 – Interface for PSTN telephone lines

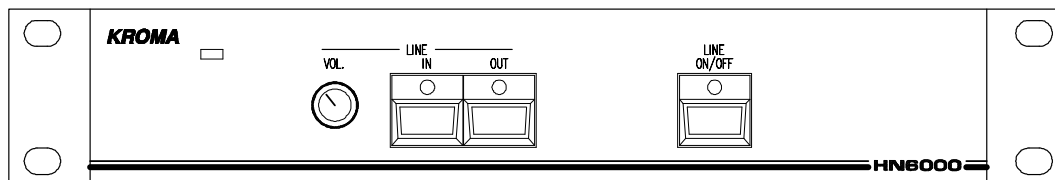
This unit interfaces with PSTN telephone lines. As Kroma intercom systems work at four wires, it converts two-line telephone signal. Commonly placed next to a standard auxiliary telephone for dialling.

When the phone set receives a call, user just needs to press the main key and hang up, thus passing the voice to the intercom system. Sidetone has been minimized.

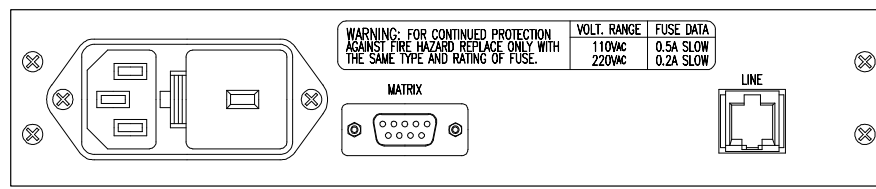
HN6000 interface is half RU and One Unit high. Two units (or one HN6000 and a blank panel) can be rack-mounted into a standard 19” rack.

The connection with the analogue matrix is via SubD and with the external telephone line through RJ11. It has volume control and Input and Output keys (for allowing telephone communication into and out of the intercom system). Main key is the hook, for establishing the dialling tone.
